DIPLOMA IN DIALYSIS TECHNOLOGY (DDT)

(Recognized by Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Kerala)

Introduction

At present there is a shortage of qualified Dialysis Technicians. This course was started to address this need and to supply necessary qualified and experienced Dialysis Technicians to hospitals in India and abroad where excellent employment opportunities await them.

1. General Information

- 1. Name of the Course: Diploma in Dialysis Technology(DDT)
- 2. Objective: To train the students to carry out various techniques of Haemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis and to perform techniques of dialysis independently.
- 3. Total Number of seats -15
- 4. Admission Requirements: Selection to 50% of seats shall be made by the Director of Medical Education and 50% by the Management. Selection will be made on the basis of merit, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination and interview
- 5. Eligibility of Admission:
 - a) Minimum Educational Qualification: Candidates who have passed HSE, Kerala or examinations recognized equivalent therto, with 40% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together. There shall be written examination and personal interview for selection if needed.
 - b) Nativity: Indian citizen of Kerala origin is eligible for admission.
 - **c)** Age limit: applicants shall have completed 17 years of age on 31.12.2021 and upper age limit is 35 as on 31.12.2021.

2. Course Content

2.1 Duration of the Course and Structure:

- The duration of the course shall be 2 years including one year internship.
- After one year of classes and practical training the candidate has to appear for examination in 2 theory papers conducted by Directorate of Medical Education (DME), Kerala. Practical examination also will be conducted by DME, Kerala.
- The successful candidates have to undergo one year of internship after which the degree will be awarded by DME, Kerala.

3. Syllabus prescribed for Diploma in Dialysis Technology

Paper I - Fundamentals of Nephrology and Dialysis Technology

General Orientation in Nephrology, History and Evaluation of Dialysis, Principles of Dialysis - Diffusion, Osmosis, Ultra Filtration, Principles of sterilization and sterile precautions, Vascular access for dialysis, Anticoagulation in Haemodialysis, Functions of dialysis monitors and Principles of its working, Artificial kidneys - evolution and types, dialyser reuse, dialyser handling, disinfections and disposal, Water quality and water treatment for dialysis, Acute haemodialysis prescription, Complications during dialysis - short term and long term, Adequacy of dialysis, Infection diseases and Infection control, Laboratory investigations in relation to dialysis.

Paper-II Recent Advance in Nephrology and Dialysis Technology

Peritoneal Dialysis, Recent advances in dialysis, H-E, H-F therapies in clinical dialysis, Alternatives in uremia therapy, Sorbent dialysis, Continuous Renal replacement therapy, Haemo perfusion and dialysis in poisoning, Plasmapheresis, Evaluation procedure.

4. Attendance: Minimum 80% required to appear in the final examination

5. Examination: at the end of 1styear

Authority to conduct Examination and award Diploma: Director of Medical Education

Theory examination: Duration -3 hrs, Maximum marks- 100 each paper

Paper-I Fundamentals of Nephrology and Dialysis Technology

Paper-II Recent Advance in Nephrology and Dialysis Technology

Practical: One day; Maximum mark-150

Criteria for a pass in the subject: Minimum of 50% marks in each of the subjects
